 I am the Co-Creator of the CHOP LEAH Reproductive Multidisciplinary Curriculum. I designed and implemented a six-session, interdisciplinary curriculum aimed at enhancing understanding and application of RJ across medicine, nursing, nutrition, psychology, and social work. The curriculum featured 10 invited speakers and was evaluated through focus groups and KAP surveys, revealing significant improvements in knowledge and practices related to RJ.
