### Chair of Black Men In and Out of the Agency, Volunteer leadership October 2020 - Present role, Office of Children, Youth and Families

As the Chair of the Black Professionals Group at Children, Youth, and Families, I took on initiatives to enhance the recruitment and leadership development of Black male professionals within the agency. I organized bi-monthly meetings to strategize and plan actionable steps aimed at raising awareness of the state of black males in this organization. I developed and presented a recruitment strategy to administration, resulting in the hiring of outside consultants to implement the plan. However, we were requesting at the time to implement our plan but wasn't' given the opportunity. What we did is put together a retention tool of our own that we call the morning huddle. Black and brown men come together every Monday for 15 minutes in the morning for a motivational message, we implemented it the first week of September in 2023. Additionally, I collaborated with administrative teams responsible for intern recruitment, collected and analyzed data, and shared insights through a virtual "Lunch and Learn" sessions. I also planned and executed an in-person male panel event, creating opportunities for dialogue and shared experiences. This work contributed to "Continuing the Conversation," a group established after George Floyd's passing, where action teams like ours report out my progress on a by-weekly bases,
